

Mushrooms nomenclatural novelties no. 9

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Subantrodia Audet, gen.nov.

It differs from *Anthrodia* s. str. by smaller basidia around 12.8-22 x 4-6.5 µm, by chlamyospores from trama and by basidiospores with no tapering distal end.

Holotype : *Agaricus juniperinus* Murrill, *Bull. Torrey bot. Club* **32**(2): 85 (1905).

Comment: The new genus is supported by the molecular analyses in Ortiz-Santana et al. 2013 (*Mycologia* 105 (6): 1391-1411) and Grebenc et al. 2008 (International Conference on Biological and Environmental Sciences : 241-248). The latin words are verified by Jean-Marie Pirlot and acknowledged here.

Etymology: the prefix sub- (from the Latin sub = under) expresses the closeness = close to the genus *Anthrodia*.
